

# Sights to explore

- 1 Tegelbacken** – Only a short walk from Stockholm Central Station where you also find the Tourist information & ticket sales office, Tours & Tickets.
- 2 Gustav Adolfs Torg - The Royal Swedish Opera** – Visit the beautiful Royal Opera House or enjoy the views from the public square, which is the most central point of Stockholm.
- 3 Old Town** – Take a walk along the Old town and enjoy its history and picturesque streets, cafés, museum and shops. Visit the Tourist information and Ticket office - Tours & Tickets on Västerlånggatan 52 for recommendations.
- 4 Southern Heights** – Probably one of the most spectacular views of Stockholm. Continue a short walk up the picturesque street Fjällgatan or walk down to the Museum - Fotografiska.
- 5 SoFo** – South of Folkungagatan, enjoy the Söder atmosphere with great range of cafés, restaurants and second hand shops. Tip! Take a short walk to Åsögatan where you'll find heritage marked houses from 18th century.
- 6 Viking Line & Cruise Line Terminal** – Ferries to Helsinki and cruise berth s167 & s160.
- 7 Medborgarplatsen** – This vibrant square is the biggest square in Stockholm, located in the heart of the trendy Södermalm area.
- 8 Skeppsbron** – This is the stop to get to our first boat stop and The Royal Bridges and Canal Tour.
- 9 Kungsträdgården** – An oasis in the heart of Stockholm where you can enjoy many events in the summer and ice skating in the winter.
- 10 Nybroplan** – The Royal Theatre was opened 1908. This beautiful art nouveau-building houses five stages. Here you'll find our boat stop.
- 11 Djurgården** – Welcome to Djurgården Island, a must visit in Stockholm. Enjoy the great range of museums, attractions and the beautiful nature.
- 12 Skansen Gröna Lund & ABBA The Museum** – Experience Skansen, the worlds oldest open Museum, Dance and sing along in ABBA The Museum or jump on the rides at the Tivoli - Gröna Lund
- 13 The Vasa Museum, Nordic Museum & Junibacken** – Visit the 17th century Vasa ship, The Nordic Museum and Junibacken - the museum of children's fairytales and theatre.
- 14 Museum park** – Experience The National Museum of Science & Technology, Etnografiska - the World culture museum, The Maritime Museum, The police Museum and the National Museum of Sports.
- 15 Frihamnen Cruise line terminal F634, F638 & F650**  
Only operated when cruise ships are in port.
- 16 Karlaplan**  
Take a walk in the heart of Östermalm and visit The National Historical Museum.
- 17 Stureplan** – The Heart of Stockholms nightlife district. Here you find Sture Gallerian Shopping Mall as well as many great restaurants, bars and night clubs.
- 18 Hötorget - Concert Hall** – Step in to the word of music in the Concert hall. Enjoy the big range of shopping at the Hötorget market or the shops at the main shopping street Drottninggatan.
- 19 Ice Bar & Central station** – Here you find the Ice bar inside the Nordic hotel. A short walk from here you also find the Central Station and Arlanda Express.
- 20 City Terminalen** – Stockholms Main Bus terminal. Here you find buses for Arlanda Airport, Skavsta Airport, Bromma Airport and Västerås Airport.
- 21 Rådhuset - Stockholm Court House** – Welcome to this vibrant part of Stockholm with many great restaurants, bars and cafés.
- 22 Stadshuset - City Hall** – Host of the annual Nobel Prize banquet and is well known for it's unique art treasures.
